# **ANNUAL CONVENTION - 2015.**

Our 46<sup>th</sup> Annual Convention will be with us again next month, and will be held on SATURDAY 23<sup>rd</sup> MAY in THE PRINCESS ROYAL THEATRE, CIVIC CENTRE, PORT TALBOT, SA13 1PJ, from 10.00am to 4.30pm, admission being 50p.

The Official Opening Ceremony will be performed by the Mayor of Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council, Cllr. Arthur Davies at 12.00 noon, and this will be followed by the Presentation of Awards, and the Raffle Prize Draw. Please note that the parking outside the Theatre is now chargeable, at £3.30 for over 4 hours, and light refreshments will be available in the hall. For those requiring something more substantial, there area number of cafes, restaurants, and pubs within a short walk, and for more detailed information, check at the Federation Table in the hall.

The Convention Programme, free on admission, contains all you need to know about the various attractions inside the hall, as well as information on the South Wales Federation and the affiliated societies. The Annual Competition entries are listed, and will be displayed on the stage. Raffle tickets will be on sale during the morning, the draw being held at around 12.30pm.

The Annual Convention is one of only two days in the year (the "Autumn Day" being the other) when the Federation asks for the active support and physical presence of its members. THIS MEANS YOU!!! So please, make every effort to come along to The Princess Royal Theatre in Port Talbot on SATURDAY 23<sup>rd</sup> MAY, even if it's only for an hour or so, as the attendance was extremely disappointing last year. Another downward trend in attendances could mean the loss of the event in its present form, the only stamp & postcard fair of its kind in Wales.

The guest speaker this year will be **Dr. Eric Coulton**, who will show parts of his **Tanganyika and German East Africa** collections. On Sunday morning, Cedric Prys-Roberts will entertain members with "A Letter from America", to be followed by a joint display when "The Ladies Entertain".

In addition to the displays, there will be a light-hearted but very keenly fought "Egg-Cup" competition, a live/postal auction of Welsh postcards and postal history, the societies Annual General Meeting, dealer-members tables, static displays, and late evening "study circle" meeting in the bar.

# SUMMER STAMP & POSTCARD FAIRS.

During the coming months, there are a number of Stamp and Postcard Fairs around the country, and those of you taking holidays or long weekends might be able to visit one or more of these during your breaks. The main fairs to consider are:

### "WORPEX".

To be held on Saturday 6 May, from 10.00am to 4.00pm at the Tudor Grange Academy, Bilford Road, WORCESTER, WR3 8HN. This is near to Junction 6 on the M 5 There will be 40+ dealers, with refreshments available and free admission, free programme, and free but limited car parking. ### "EUROPHILEX, LONDON 2015".

This International Exhibition will be held at The Business Design Centre, Upper Street, Islington, London, N1 0QH, from 13 – 16 May, with 125+ dealers & postal administrations. Doors open at 10.00am, with a £10.00 entry charge on the first day, with free entry on other days. In addition, there will be 1500 frames of competitive exhibits and invited displays. ### "SWINPEX".

Another popular one-day fair, to be held on Saturday, 13 June, from 10.00am to 4.30pm at St. Joseph's Catholic College, Ocotal Way, Swindon, SN3 3LR. There will be around 46 dealers attending, with some 12 specialist societies holding morning or afternoon meetings. Light refreshments are available and there is ample free parking. Admission is £1.00 by Programme.

### "MIDPEX"

This well-attended and popular event, held on alternate years, will take place on Saturday 4 July at the Warwickshire Exhibition Centre, Fosse Way, LEAMINGTON SPA, CV31 1XN. Although an out of town location and difficult to find, there is ample free car parking. There are usually about 70 dealers present, plus 40 specialist societies. ### VORK

To be held at the York Racecourse Grandstand, on Friday 17 and Saturday 18 July, with free admission and ample car parking. This is probably the best fair outside London, and there are usually around 100 dealers (plus 50 coin dealers) present. There is also the historic city of York, with its many attractions, making this a great place to spend a weekend or more, there is so much to see in the city and the surrounding countryside.

### PORTISHEAD.

A popular fair for south Wales collectors, I believe that this will be held at the Gordano Comprehensive School, Portishead on Saturday 15 August, although this date has yet to be confirmed.

### "AUTUMN DAY" STAMP & POSTCARD FAIR.

To date, I have not yet received confirmation that any society is prepared to host our annual autumn gettogether. Both Carmarthen and Llanelli clubs have been unable to make any arrangements, and I am now waiting for Bridgend and/or Barry to contact me.

It would be a great shame if 2015 became the first year since the first event in 1979, in Cowbridge, that we will have failed to hold an "Autumn Day".
