# **ANNUAL CONVENTION – 2016.**

Our 47<sup>th</sup> Annual Convention will be with us again next month, and will be held on **SATURDAY 21<sup>st</sup> MAY**, in **THE PRINCESS ROYAL THEATRE, CIVIC CENTRE, PORT TALBOT, SA13 1PJ**, from **10.00am to 4.30pm**, admission being **50p**.

The Official Opening Ceremony will be performed by the Mayor of Neath Port Talbot, Cllr. Sheila Penry at 12.00 noon, and this will be followed by the Presentation of Awards and the Raffle Prize draw. Please note that the parking outside the Theatre is chargeable, at £3.00 for over 4 hours. Tea/coffee will be available in the hall, and for those requiring something more substantial there are a number of cafes, restaurants & pubs within a short walk. # THE WELSH POSTAL HISTORY SOCIETY.

The Welsh Postal History Society will be holding its 40<sup>th</sup> Annual Residential Weekend in the Snowdonia National Park Study Centre (Plas Tan y Bwlch), near Porthmadog, from Thursday 16 June to Sunday 19 June.

The guest speaker this year will be Mr. Keith Brandon, from Kirkbymoorside, North Yorkshire, and Keith will be showing parts of his Austrian collection. The displays by members this year will be by Prof. Cedric Prys-Roberts, with "The postal history of Caernarvon and District" and Richard Farman with "The Development of the Parcel Post".

In addition to the displays, there will be a light-hearted but very keenly fought "Egg Cup" competition, a live/postal auction of Welsh postcards and postal history, the Annual General Meeting of the society, static displays, dealer-members tables, and the late evening "study circle" meeting in the bar.

The most recent meeting of the society was held last month in **Aberystwyth**, when Society Archivist **Prof. Cedric Prys-Roberts** continued his exploration into the use of the "Climax" rubber date-stamp, this time concentrating on the North Wales counties, with contributions from members having these in their collections.

#### SUMMER STAMP & POSTCARD FAIRS.

During the summer months, there are a number of Stamp and Postcard Fairs around the country, and those of you taking holidays or long weekends might be able to visit one or more of these during your breaks. The main ones to consider are:

#### "WORPEX".

To be held on Saturday 14 May, from 10.00am to 4.00pm at the Tudor Grange Academy, Bilford Road. Worcester, WR3 8HN. This is close to Junction 6 on the M5, and there will be around 45 dealers, with free admission and refreshments are available. #### SALISBURY COLLECTORS SHOW.

This is a two-day show at the City Hall, Salisbury, on Friday 13 and Saturday 14 May, with around 30 dealers. For further information, see <a href="https://www.salisburyshow.co.uk">www.salisburyshow.co.uk</a>.

#### "SWINPEX".

This popular and well-attended fair will be held on Saturday 11 June from 10.00am to 4.30pm, at St. Joseph's Catholic College, Ocotal Way, Swindon, SN3 3LR. There will be around 45 dealers attending, with some 12 specialist societies holding morning or afternoon meetings. Light refreshments are available, and there is ample free car parking, with. free admission.

#### YORK.

This will be held at the York Racecourse Grandstand YO23 1AX on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> and Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> July, with free admission and ample car parking. This is probably the best fair outside London, and there are usually around 100 dealers (plus 50 coin/banknote dealers). In addition this year, there will be a full National Exhibition with all classes.

#### PORTISHEAD.

A popular fair for South Wales collectors, held at the Gordano Comprehensive School, Portishead. Although the date has yet to be confirmed, I believe it will be on Saturday13 August.

# "AUTUMN DAY" STAMP & POSTCARD FAIR.

The Port Talbot club will be hosting this year's event, on SATURDAY 17 SEPTEMBER, in the Taibach Community Centre, Duke Street, Margam, Port Talbot, SA13 1NA.
